Excursion to **BESSE** Village and the **AUVERGNE Lakes** Monday, 13th of May 2024



Departure by coach for Lac Pavin: discover this lake of volcanic origin, the youngest volcano in France at an altitude of 1,197m. Besse Village: Free time at the market to discover local produce. Lunch on your own. Continuing on to the Col de Croix-Morand, at an altitude of 1,401 m, which offers magnificent panoramic views and has hosted the Tour de France on several occasions. On to Lac de Guéry, a volcanic dam created by a basaltic lava flow: magnificent panorama of the Massif du Sancy and the Chaîne des Puys. View of the Tuilière and Sanadoire rocks, the remains of two volcanoes forming part of the Sancy-Monts Dore complex, eroded by glaciers. All that remains are the chimney (Tuilière) and a piece of the cone (Sanadoire) separated by a trough-shaped valley. Continue towards Orcival. Discover the Basilique Notre-Dame, nestling in a green setting in the heart of the Parc des Volcans d'Auvergne, one of the five Romanesque churches in the region. Return to Cournon Zenith d'Auvergne.
